## 10 tips to get the most out of CyberBOX

- 1. Don't be afraid to try CyberBOX.**

It is a freely accessible initial cyber security training on the CZECH.UP JukeBOX platform, which you can order access from CZECH.UP.
- 2. Try to understand and live your character.**

Once you start the training, a virtual character is created for you. The options available below are closely tied to the settings for this role. Putting yourself in "your" character will help you better fulfill individual tasks and understand the life decisions of the social groups that this character characterizes.
- 3. Maximize your "gaming" experience.**

Training in CyberBOX is built on experience. The "gaming" experience is enhanced by multiple passes (starting a training). In each pass, you will get acquainted with the initial situation of the assigned character and with other differently ordered tasks that await you during the training. The aim is to convey an experience in order to consolidate competence in this area. You will develop the ability to respond adequately in different situations.
- 4. Develop team skills**

If you train together in a team, which is allowed by higher versions of trainings that follow this one, you can deepen the conversations about your experiences and strengthen your competencies. You won't have to go through so many situations on your own, because you will gain some competencies at the sharing level.
- 5. Don't click, but think.**

Some of the situations will be reflected in the next rounds. It is good to gradually clarify how effective a reaction to a particular situation is.
- 6. Do not fall into the trap of accumulating wealth.**

Don't measure the resources you've accumulated in training. Every life situation is different and in a combination of some you can not make a mistake, and vice versa the interplay of some situations does not even allow finish the training. CyberBOX evaluates tasks.
- 7. Take advantage of a live mentor.**

Part of CZECH.UP JukeBOX is a network of certified CZECH.UP and NARA-SK methodologists, who are authorized to present the product. By using feedback on your training progress, you will significantly deepen your skills and get the maximum benefit from the training.
- 8. Get help.**

If you are not sure about training, do not hesitate to contact us. Cooperation will allow you to train, but it can help to improve this LP, or the whole CZECH.UP JukeBOX.
- 9. Report ambiguities.**
